

HOW TO PREPARE FOR BOARDING OR EDUCATION STAY

We understand that it's an anxious moment when you drop off your 4-legged family member for a stay away from home. We're here to help organize your visit and put your mind at easy.

We welcome all pet owners to come and view or facilities prior to your 4-legged family members stay. Please reach out so we can schedule.

Items we require once you decide for use to Care for your 4-legged family member.

1) Vaccination records are needed for all pets; vaccine requirements are as follows:

- Rabies
- Bordetella
- DHLPP (Distemper)
- Negative fecal results within the past 6 months, then required annually.
- Canine Influenza (H3N2 & H3N8) Recommended not required.

2) Completion of our Boarding and Education Contract (Prior to drop off is required)

ITEMS TO BRING FOR DROP OFF

- Your pet's own food. We strongly encourage you to bring your pets own food, which helps to avoid a possible upset tummy.
- **Daily Medications**: eyedrops, allergy medications, herbs, supplements
- Monthly Medications: Heartworm, Flea preventative (especially if they are due during their time of stay)



HOW TO PACK FOR YOUR BOARDING OR EDUCATION STAY

- Food: Please bring enough food for an extra week, have their First and Last name on container or zip-lock bags. We will discuss their feeding habits at drop off (ex. AM/PM feeding or once a day feeding, Amount, with or without water.)
- **Medication**: Please keep any medication or supplements in their original packaging
- **Bedding/blankets**: Are allowed if your pet is on Fleas preventative.
- **Toys**: Are allowed please place their name on the item. Provide items that won't be missed if they are chewed or misplaced.
- **Treats**: In there original packaging with Pets name on it and amount to give

WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Food: We will have Nutra-Source if your pet is in need (\$5.00 a meal)
- Water: is automatically provided in each kennel
- **Bowl/Dishe**s: are provided and dish washed every evening
- Raised bed
- Fleece blanket

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARRIVE WITH YOUR PET

You and your 4-legged family member will be welcomed by the owners or trainer. Your pet will need to be always on leash. Your family will be escorted into our drop off area. At this time, we will take your pets belongings and do a physical review of your animal with you. We will provide you with a few moments to say your goodbyes. Your pet will then be removed from the area, and we will go over paperwork.
